What sounds more boring than 'World Communications Sunday'...for which we have to take a second collection? Something else which sounds boring and tedious is the requirement for us to develop a new Data Protection Policy. Why?

Yet these things are important, not because they are about 'things' but about people. So, following the Ascension of Jesus to Heaven, the Church directs us towards asking the Holy Spirit to help us continue Christ's work on earth. And above all, this means communicating it. But the big question is '*how do we do this?*'

This is the challenge facing our Island Church and to which we must all actively respond and become involved:

- Passing on the faith more effectively to our children and young people;
- Developing among all practising Catholics a better understanding of Church Teaching in faith and morals;
- Training for our convinced and dedicated catechists to carry forward this mission;

As for collecting and protecting data it is essential to keep it updated. So today, please take one of our Church Registration forms for our database PAMIS (parish administration

management system) and either update if needed or complete a form if you haven't already done so. Please return forms to your area office for processing.

The new General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) comes into effect on **25 May** and we are working closely with the diocese to ensure we are compliant.

When, at the touch of a button, I can email an Island letter to you all, I can be more effective than St Paul with his more laborious means of writing epistles.
