## THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK



It was St Augustine who said: "*The Old is in the New revealed, the New is in the Old concealed.*" What

Augustine meant is that the entirety of the New Testament is concealed or hidden within the Old Testament, while the Old Testament is revealed to us believers in Christ in the New Testament.

To *reveal* means to make known some previously hidden secret. In today's Gospel we hear St Mark's account of the Transfiguration of Our Lord. We hear about the great revelation, that moment when the greatest secret is made known to mankind. St Mark shares with us how Peter, James and John (who like the other disciples still believe Jesus to be the earthly messiah) are let into the divine secret of who Jesus Christ really is. They hear the voice of God the Father Himself declare, "*This is My Son, the Beloved. Listen to Him.*"

Peter, James and John are not alone on the

mountain with Jesus; rather they are in the presence of the two greatest Old Testament prophets, Moses and Elijah. The symbolism is clear - Christ has come not to abolish the Law laid down by Moses but to fulfil it in His radiance. Christ has come to reveal the fullness of the Old Testament to His followers. He has come to restore the intimate friendship Adam and Eve enjoyed with their Creator. The wholeness of the teaching of the Old Testament now stands revealed on the mountain in the form of the transfigured Christ.

By our baptism each of us is called to share in the glory of Jesus' transfigured body. That is what God the Father wishes for each of us. It's the reason He created us - to be with Him. By the mystery of His Son's incarnation, death and resurrection, He gives us the means to bridge the gulf our first parents created between us and Him. By the grace of the Holy Spirit we can bridge our own gulf and live in the fullness of Christ.

*I wish you a blessed Lent.*
