THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

'Repent and believe in the Gospel'

I was reading recently about the origins and meaning of the word 'repentance' and came across a suggestion that an appropriate translation, in this particular context, might be to 'change direction', 'turn around' or have a 'change of heart'.

As we prepare for the great season of Lent we have a very unique opportunity to receive God's grace afresh and then to seek to respond to it. This suggests that we might seriously consider how we might do things differently. It is good to challenge ourselves and seek to reason as to why we do things ... why do we come to Mass and receive Holy Communion and not come regularly to Confession and reconcile ourselves?

We are created to praise, worship and love God and by doing this, save our souls. Much of what we know and experience of today's society, the 'Secular Society', is completely at odds with what we claim to stand for and believe and yet we seem to drift along with it and 'go with the flow'.

Lent could be an opportunity to pause and reflect, to spend time with Jesus, in the Presence of the Blessed Sacrament and ask ourselves, do we really repent? Do we really believe in the Gospel? This is the essential Christian challenge; to think differently in order that we too might change - and in so doing change the world. *"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, my ways not your ways ..."* (Isaiah 55:8-13.) The early Christians succeeded in being and bringing light into a fundamentally secular and pagan society because they **were** different, because they **were** attractive.

Blessed John Henry Newman very wisely said, *'In a higher world it is otherwise, but here below to live is to change, and to be perfect is to have changed often.'* (An Essay on the Development of Christian Doctrine.)

We read in today's Gospel that the reason Jesus cured the Leper was because the Leper asked and Jesus responded, *'Of course I want to'* ... (Mark 1.42). This is our opportunity to ask Jesus to change our hearts, to help us turn around to change direction. Even to be sufficiently attractive to be a light to the word ... *"Let there be peace on earth and let it begin with me."*

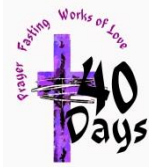
