## THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Today is the fourth Sunday of Lent and is known as 'Lætáre' Sunday. If available, the vestments worn today may be rose coloured rather than violet, as during the rest of Lent. The Church knows us well and because both Lent and Advent are long stretches of time to be contemplating repentance, in her wisdom, she gives us a break in both of these seasons. In Advent we are told to rejoice, 'Gaudéte', on the third Sunday and in Lent it is the fourth Sunday which calls us to be joyful, 'Lætáre' as we look forward to the great celebration of Easter.

Traditionally this was the day when people would visit their Mother Church. That might be their home church, the church they were baptised in or the Cathedral. This is how today became known as Mothering Sunday. Families gathering in the church would bring flowers to give to their mothers and this developed into the Mother's Day we celebrate also today.

This is a good day to assess how well we have been accompanying Jesus during his forty days in the wilderness. Have we been fasting from something meaningful which will make a difference to our lives? Have we been praying a little more by joining one of the many opportunities given to us across our Island Parish? Have we sought reconciliation through confession, and have we been giving food, water, clothing and support to Jesus by giving to his most needy subjects? There is still plenty of Lenten time left and, following this little pause in the middle, we can continue refreshed on our journey towards Easter.

Let us today take stock of how our Lenten journey is going. Let us be joyful in anticipation of Easter, give thanks for our mother church and take the opportunity in this little break in Lent to celebrate what we have to be thankful to our own mothers for.
